

Call for Candidates by Oct. 1, 2019

Four (4) Vacancies on the Board of Directors

ELECTIONS HELD IN ROTATION TO ENSURE CONTINUITY OF EXPERIENCE ON THE BOARD. Per the Bylaws, commencing with the Fall 2017 election, four (4) of ASDCE's eight (8) Directors end terms on the Board creating vacancies on December 31, 2019. ASDCE's Board of eight (8) Directors are eligible members, elected-at-large by majority vote of the entire membership. Directors serve a 3 year term on the Board. Terms are by calendar year from January 1st to December 31st. Directors can serve an unlimited number of terms therefore incumbent Directors may choose to run for re-election for another 3 year term. If incumbent directors run for re-election and are unopposed, the election will be canceled and the candidates will be declared elected as unopposed. **For any members who wish to serve a 3 year term on the Board, please declare your candidacy by October 1, 2019.**

Eligibility Requirements:

- Candidates must be a County employee for at least one (1) one continuous year;
- Candidates must be an ASDCE member for at least (1) one continuous year;
- Candidates must be a member of ASDCE in "Good Standing".
- All completed & signed "Candidate Declaration Forms" must be received by the October 1, 2019 deadline.

How to Declare Candidacy for Election to the Board

Candidates declare their intention in writing, to seek election to the Board of Directors, on a form prescribed by the Board (*enclosed*) and must be filed with the Secretary/Treasurer **no later than October 1st, 2019**. Upcoming vacancies on the Board are for four (4) Directors, who are Executive Officers and whose responsibilities are to:

- Meet regularly four (4) times per year.
- There are eight (8) Directors on the Board. Four (4) Directors are Executive Officers and four are (4) Directors-at-large hold voting positions on the Board. (*The President who is an Executive Officer, votes only to break a tie*)
- The job of the Board of Directors is to act diligently with reasonable skill and prudence to exercise the non-profit corporate responsibility and fiduciary duties of the Association consistent with the Bylaws and applicable provisions of law.
- Directors may be asked to serve on committees (*e.g. Bargaining Committee*) by the President, if agreed.
- Board members do not receive paid compensation for service but any expenses incurred will be reimbursed ASAP.
